This research paper tries to know the ground picture of the empowerment of women in the day to day lives in Delhi. The present research has been conducted via primary data collection focusing on the true empowerment picture of women in the society. The socio-economic development of women in each family for the betterment of the generations and the nation is the primary agenda of women empowerment. The present research focuses on the development of the women despite being helped from the government of the nation for various aspects in order to get a clear frame of the condition of women in 2021. The research was conducted with the help of two surveys conducted in rural and urban areas respectively wherein, the interrogation focused regarding the education, income at workplaces, say in families, support by government policy initiatives, independency as a whole, the favorability of the implication of the 'Pink Tax' on the goods consumed by females and the income disparities faced by the women at workplaces while the rural women were also questioned about their ability to read and write their names. The conclusions drawn have considered the sample size of 440 responses from the women belonging to urban parts (220 Respondents) and rural parts (220 Respondents) of Delhi.
